# How to make a regular dodecahedron 



Take a piece of A4 paper. Find the centre by folding it in half twice.


Fold one corner to the centre.


Repeat for each of the four corners, working your way around.


Fold in half along the vertical, locking the tabs together.


Fold the corner up so it lands on your original crease line, making a right angle.

Repeat this until you have twelve pentagons. The flaps can be used to assemble them into a dodecahedron*!
